

LOCKER POLICIES

- 1. All lockers are the property of UCLA Recreation. Locks on all lockers are issued by, and are the property of UCLA Recreation. A \$10.00 fee will be assessed for any missing locks. A fee up to \$500 will be assessed by the Facility Manager for any damageto the locker.
- 2. Lockers may only be rented by currently-registered UCLA students or people who hold an active UCLA Recreation membership.
- 3. UCLA Recreation is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged personal property
- 4. UCLA Recreation reserves the right to terminate your locker agreement at any time for any campus security violations, student misconduct, and/or member misconduct.
- 5. Any locker not renewed by the deadline will be subject to a \$5.00 clearance fee to retrieve uncollected belongings. Any items not collected within 30 days will be discarded/donated.

Locker Usage Policy

- 1. Lockers may only be used for legitimate purposes involving exercise, sports, and fitness. Use of any locker for inappropriate or unlawful purposes is prohibited and subject to search and forfeiture of items found.
- 2. Strictly prohibited inside the lockers: Flammable materials, dangerous chemicals, explosives or weapons of any kind, perishable items, illegal or controlled substances, such as drugs or alcohol.
- 3. DO NOT STORE EXPENSIVE OR VALUABLE ITEMS IN YOUR LOCKER LONG-TERM. Jewelry, expensive sporting equipment, portable electronics, and other similar items should only be stored during your workout, if necessary, not for days or weeks at a time. It is always best to leave any valuable items secured at home. Again, UCLA Recreation is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- 4. Please be considerate of your neighbors. Unlaundered clothing, worn protective gear, leaking oil bottles and other similar items that create unpleasant odors and messes, or that leak to other lockers are prohibited.
- 5. UCLA Recreation reserves the right to cut the locks of such locker, remove the contents and dispose of as deemed necessary.
- 6. Don't share your locker or your lock combination.
- 7. Please lock your locker!

Day Use Locker Usage

1. UCLA Recreation reserves the right to cut day-use locks and remove locker contents if left after hours.



- 2. Some contents, such as personal hygiene products or underclothes cannot be received by the lost and found, therefore they will be discarded. After 10 days, ALL items are discarded/donated.
- 3. A \$5.00 clearance fee will be assessed to retrieve items left in day use lockers.

Locker Clearance Policies

- 1. It is the responsibility of the member to renew their locker prior to the posted deadline. Any locker rental term not renewed by its expiration date is subject to forfeiture, no exceptions. Items left inside the locker will be removed, the lock changed, and the locker resold.
- 2. Any items removed by Recreation Management from expired or unauthorized rental lockers are held in storage for up to 30 days. If the items are not reclaimed, they will be donated or disposed of.
- 3. A \$5.00 clearance fee will be assessed to retrieve items left in expired lockers.
- 4. UCLA Recreation is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged personal property.
