Job Qualifications

Required

- Currently enrolled as a UCLA Student
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Ability to work a minimum of 8 hours a week, including early mornings, late nights, weekends, holidays and other university closure dates.

Preferred

- Work Study eligible.
- Familiarity with Departmental and University policies.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Comfortable with learning new software quickly.
- Previous experience in customer service and administrative duties.
- Appointment may be extended through the next academic year upon request.
- Continued summer availability is preferred.

Job Expectations

- Process sales of recreation memberships, programs, and services through our licensed POS system
- Ensure all cash handling procedures meet University policies and are PCI compliant.
- Supports all aspect of customer service via email and phone.
- Assist members with accessing accounts and making online registrations and bookings.
- Ability to maintain professionalism while managing multiple challenging requests via phone and email.
- Enforce all university and departmental policies while communicating expectations effectively to members. Report policy violations through proper channels in a timely manner.
- Assume responsibility for emergency situations, as specified in the Emergency Action Plan.
- Arrive to all shifts, meetings, and other work obligations on-time, in proper uniform, and with a professional appearance and attitude.
- Perform other duties as assigned by professional staff.
- Flexible with work locations, including Sunset Canyon Recreation Center, John Wooden Center, and remote work.
- Commitment to complete all trainings mandated by the university, attend all mandatory training sessions, all-staff meetings, and regular check-ins with supervisor.
