Job Qualifications

Required

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Have First Aid/CPR certifications (by first day of employment)
- Submit to criminal background check.
- Experience working in recreation department and/or related field.
- Possess effective interpersonal skills and a strong desire to learn.
- Be willing to work variable and extended hours.
- Valid Driver's License
- Be willing to drive university vehicles
- Be legally allowed to work in the United States

Preferred

- Experience with staff supervision
- Able to work with a wide variety of personalities

Job Expectations

- Develop and manage staff incentive program.
- Create and facilitate Staff Development Series.
- Conduct staff evaluations with Youth and Family Programs staff.
- Schedule and conduct one-on-one staff check-ins, provide constructive feedback to improve overall staff and patron experience.
- Help with a weeklong training at UCLA's Bruin Woods camp site in Lake Arrowhead

Pay Rate

Each intern will be paid \$400/biweekly, plus a full University Housing and Dining plan (the housing and meal package is estimated at \$4,150 and is treated as taxable income by the IRS).
